

#### BLOGGING YOUR PROJECTS

#### Setting up the Blog

There are many companies that offer free blog service. Both Wordpress and Blogger are excellent examples of these services. Setting up your blog starts with signing up and starting to blog. In many cases, there are free templates that you download and use that will help your blog stand out from the basic templates that are offered.

#### What to Blog About

Simple, write about . everything that you wish other people to know about; such as your arts and sciences projects or your service related goals would be appropriate for blogging. Think of the blog as your ongoing research

and documentation notes. Working on a leatherworking project? Show your • readers the steps you took to complete the project. Running a Coronet? Blog about your experiences, both good and bad, to document your learning. There are so many different things you can discuss on a blog, limited only by your creative imagination.

#### Tips for Project Blogging

- Take a lot of pictures of your progress and post them to the blog.
- Link your blog to your favorite social media. such as Facebook, so that others can see what you are working on.
- Post often to keep reader interest up, but don't feel obligated to

- post when you are not working on a project.
- List your resources when applicable.
- Write in a normal tone. just as if you were discussing your subject with a person face to face.

Utilizing blogs to document your progress on any type of project can be extremely beneficial to you. It keeps a record of what you did so you can go back and see what objects you made. It also offers other people a chance to learn how you did a project and steer away from pitfalls that you may have encountered.


A reminder that you do not have to have been given an Award of arms (AoA) in order to register a coat of arms or your name. This can be done prior to receiving the award.

So please contact me via email or give me a call and we will get you on the road to registration.


