Take the Palmer exit at the Glenn Highway/Parks Highway interchange. **Follow the Glenn Highway to the Alaska State Fair sign. Turn right into the main parking lot. Go through the parking lot to the Red Gate. Park and walk through the gate. The Colony Church is just inside the Red Gate on the right-hand side.

Selviergard Warlords Tournament

Friday August 18 to Sunday August 20, 2023 Being held at Houston City Campground.

Baroness Vicana of Selviergard will host a Warlords Tournament to find Her Champions! We will be celebrating in conjunction with the Houston Founders Day on August 19th. The site is the Houston City campground off Armstrong. The site opens August 18th starting at 4 pm and closes at 4 pm on Sunday. This is a rural campground, so choose your footwear carefully. There are porta privies which are permanent structures and additional temporary porta privies will be provided. The terrain is uneven, and the campground is adjacent to a lake and a river. Mosquitoes and flies are bound to be plentiful, and please be on the lookout for bear, coyote and wolves.

Camping is additional to the site fee with \$20 per campsite. It is requested that each camp site bring a fire extinguisher. Schedule: Friday 4pm gates open for set up. Soup and bread will be available to fuel our energy. A Bardic fire is planned for Friday after setup. Baronial Court will be 11am. An armored combat tournament will be immediately after court to determine a Selviergard Warlord. A rapier tournament will immediately follow that to determine the Selviergard Rapier Champion. Styles of combat will be the Baroness's whim. Founders Day Celebration begins at 5 pm Saturday in the Community Center Parking lot. The SCA is providing a fighting demo during the festivities. Free hot dogs will be provided by the City of Houston or you may purchase from the food trucks. Following the SCA fighting demo will be fireworks, then back to the campground for Bardic at the fire. Sunday the site has a Hard Close at 4pm. Looking forward to seeing you there.




FROM THE CHRONICLER
