Shared Bites

Baron Colum's Guinness Ice-cream

1 qt. half-and-half

- 1/2 cup sweetened condensed milk
- 2 cups whipping cream
- 1 tablespoon vanilla extract
- 1 cup Guinness stout
- 2 tablespoon molasses

1/4 teaspoon salt

1/2 cup sugar

In the medium saucepan, mix in the half and half, condensed milk, cream and vanilla. Bring to a boil over medium heat. Turn off the heat, cover the pan, and let the flavors infuse for about 30 minutes.

In the small saucepan over medium-high heat, whisk together the stout, sugar, salt and molasses. Bring to a boil and turn off heat.

Stir the beer mixture into the cream mixture in a bowl and refrigerate for at least 2 hours or overnight. Process the mixture in an ice cream maker according to the manufacturer's instructions.
