
# The Guardian

## Shared Bites

#### Flower Infused Sugar

Spring brings you a barage of edible treats in the form of wild rose, lilac, violets, spruce tips and many more. One of my favorite spring time treats is to infuse sugars with the blooms of spring. Taking any wild flowers that are edible adding them to sugar (regular or raw sugar will work) you will have a true taste of spring to add to teas or cocktails! Add a spoon or rim your glass and get ready for a new twist to your normal bevreges!

Recipe: 1 cup sugar to ½ cup or so of blossoms (you can make larger batches just use the 2 to 1 ratio) 1 part flower blossoms: Pick your blossoms and separate them from the stems and green caps so you have nothing but blossom (Your blossoms may Change in color but its all good I promise) 2 parts of your sugar of your liking In a mason jar (use the size you need to hold the amount of sugar your making layer sugar and blossoms back and forth till your done. Then vigorusly shake the jar, store in a dark cool area for about 24 hours. Your sugar may look lumpy or moist its ok pour that sugar out on a cookie sheet and let it dry for a few hours, add it back into a dried jar and let stew for 3 or 4 days shaking it a round every day to get it all melding together. Now my granny she liked to morter and pestle it together im a modern gal so I use the food processer or nijna blender and make it my own. I put mine in small 4oz jars and give it as gifts and enjoy the stash I keep for myself.


#### Constable Deputy Wanted.
