- The Order of the Silver/Bronze/Iron Moose** – For excellence in the fields of Service, Arts and Sciences, and Martial Activity (resp.) within the Barony.

Should these awards be added?

Is it inspiring? Would you like to receive it?

Is the name good or is there a better idea?

Can you think of anyone to recommend it to?

You can **check ones you like** and not others.

We will only adopt ones with clear affirmation by you.

Populace vote on new awards at Michaelmas? Is that in the works? Khevron is working on it.





RECIPE CORNER

This edition's recipe provided by Ellisif y Reykyavik

Welcome to our new feature, a recipe corner! This spot will give you period recipes from many times and places to try yourself. All of these will have been tested locally and most will have been served at feasts or potlucks. You will notice that in the originals, there aren't quantities of ingredients given, or cooking times, and are often easier to understand if you read them out loud. They were more like reminders to experienced cooks, rather than complete instructions. The great thing is that this leaves room to adjust things to your own liking. Later on, the recipes will be found in the "files" section of the Baronial Facebook page.

RECIPE CORNER

BUTTERED CAULIFLOWER

This dish was served at Michaelmas 2014, themed as a Family Dinner, and at Winter Coronet in Juneau about 2012.

Original recipe: Buttered Colleflowre (from A Booke of Cookerie, John Murrell, 1617.

Take a ripe Colle-floure and cut off the buddes, boyle them in milke with a little Mace until they be very tender, then poure them into a Cullender, and let the Milke runne cleane from them, then take a ladle full of Creame, being boyled with a little whole Mace, putting to it a Ladlefull of thicke butter, mingle them together with a little Sugar, dish up your flowres upon sippets, poure your butter and cream hot upon it strowing on a little slicst Nutmeg and salt, and serve it to the Table hot.

Note: A sippet is a piece of toasted or fried bread, used to soak up the sauce from dishes like this.

Modern version:

Heat 3 cups milk. As it gets warm, add ¼ teaspoon mace and 1 cut-up cauliflower. Simmer (try not to let it boil, or the milk curdles) until the cauliflower is tender (or to your preferred doneness), 12-15 minutes.

In a separate pot, heat ½ cup heavy cream, 1 Tablespoon butter, ¼ teaspoon salt, ¼ teaspoon nutmeg, and ¼ teaspoon sugar until hot but don't let it boil.

When the cauliflower's done, strain it out of the milk, pile it on top of crisp toast, and pour the sauce over it. Alternately, put the cauliflower in a bowl and add the sauce.

Business Meeting, Oct. 19th, 2023

REVIEW OF MICHAELMAS

Not as good attendance as anticipated. 27 had said they wanted feast. Plus 7 kids, but we had 18 adults and 3 kids. Lot of people got sick.

Circulating pump for city steam failed so no hot water or heat, but not too cold. Now it is taken care of. (But they've always had trouble getting hot water in the kitchen). 

My dearest children, whom I have missed greatly: Travel has gone smoothly, and we should be arriving home in a few days! Please make sure all the tables are in good condition for a feast to welcome home Peite and his family. Peite's wife Darya is bringing a wagon full of spices and several scrolls of her mama's recipes. I look forward to including some of her exotic foods in the feast.

I am very sad to have to tell you that I tried, but was unable to bring you home a kamul. Darya and I bought 2 of them from a caravan we met along the way. They're very strong and can carry great loads. But one morning they were gone, and I found their tethering ropes frayed and broken. I hope they chewed their way free and can find their way to their homeland. (I do have some suspicions, as none of the men could tolerate them. Your own father was the worst with the poor kamuls, especially after one of them bit him and the other trod on his foot. He even refused to call them by the names I gave to them!)

To me they were the sweetest creatures, with large eyes and long eyelashes that look sad when they don't get a treat. I was looking forward to seeing how the long, soft fur they shed would weave into extra-warm blankets.

We had to buy another wagon to carry what the kamuls had. It irritated your father greatly. He keeps muttering about extra expenses and the idiocy of going shopping when on a long journey. I smile to myself.

Greetings one and all,

Another letter was found a few years back but only recently have scholars linked it to the Michaelmas Letters. Below is the Darya Letter.

Greetings Mama,

We arrived in the lands of my husband with little adventure. Peite's family and friends held a welcoming feast that was quite good. Ellisif said some of your recipes would go well with their northern ingredients. I think the success is due to the genius of your recipes since they can be easily adapted.

Speaking of adapting, my husband is very easily adapting back into his native lands, especially with a drink called mead. I fully blame his cousin Hallbiorn, he is so very uncouth!

To be fair to Hallbiorn, he was correct that my husband was needed here. The local bishop is as bad as Hallbiorn said, very typical of the Roman priests who keep showing up acting as if they are God's gift to mankind! The bishop's plans were thwarted by our arrival and we arrived with little time to spare. 


