Beef Y-Stywyd

This has been the "barony-provided" meat dish at many events. Somehow, there's never any left at the end of the evening ...

(Hint: this is much easier to understand (and more fun) if you read it aloud)

Original: Take fayre beef of the rybbys of the fore quarterys, an smyte in fayre pecys, and wasche the beef into a fayre potte; than take the water that the beef was sothin yn, an strayne it thorw a straynowr, an seethe the same water and beef in a potte, an let hem boyle togederys; than take canel, cloves, maces, graynys of parise, quibibes, and oynons y-mynced, perceli, an sawge, an caste ther-to, an let hem boyle to-gederys; an than take a lof of brede, an stepe it with brothe an venegre, an than draw it thorw a straynore, and let it be stylle; an whan it is nere y-now, caste the lycour ther-to, but nowt to moche, an than let boyle onys, an cast safroun ther-to a quantyte; than take salt an venegre, an cast ther-to, an loke that it be poynount y-now, and serve forth.

1 lb stew beef cut in cubes

1 onion, chopped

1 Tbsp olive oil

½ tsp salt

5 cups water

11 cubebs, crushed

34 tsp grains of paradise, crushed

1/4 tsp mace powder

1 tsp dried sage

1/4 tsp cinnamon

6 whole cloves

1 Tbsp dried parsley

2 pinches saffron

½ cup breadcrumbs

1 Tbsp vinegar (preferably red wine or apple cider vinegar)

Brown the beef cubes about 3 min per side in a shallow pan, then remove. Dump in 1 cup water to get the lovely browned bits off the pan. Put beef and water in your stewing pot.

Add the oil to the pan, then onion and salt. Let the onion cook until it starts to brown. Add it to the stewing pot.

To the stewing pot, add the rest of the water and spices, and bring to a boil. Reduce heat, cover and let simmer for 1-1/2 to 2 hours or until meat is tender. (OR cook in Instant Pot under pressure for 30 minutes, OR cook in Crockpot on low for 7-8 hours).

Pick out the meat and put it into a bowl. Bring the broth to a boil. Add breadcrumbs and vinegar. Let it boil until the volume is reduced by half. It will thicken a bit. Remove the cloves and put the meat back into the broth. Serve it forth.

HAMLETDa'ud Bob Movie Review

Let me start out by saying that I am, to say the least, not a big fan of modern music composed by people who think that discordant notes with little to no trace of an actual melody. Indeed, I have never really understood, nor liked, such "Arty with a capital A" music. I find it pretentious, affected, and hard to listen to. This is not to say that I dislike music in general; I was raised on, and played both in band and orchestra, all kinds of music, from popular through classical through folk and more. But you need to be aware of my bias against such music going in to this month's movie review, because it is an opera written in just such a style. Not that I have a problem with opera per se. I don't. I am familiar with, and have enjoyed watching, a wide variety of operas, from Madame Butterfly, though Turandot, to Pagliacci, to Carmen (which Anna Sue has an issue with; she believes that Carmen takes way too long to die!), and even P.D.Q. Bach's The Abduction of Figaro.

But this production is not like any of those. And clearly, not everyone shares my bias; the Classical Music Critic for the New York Times extolled it. (You can find his review on-line at https://www.nytimes.com/2022/05/15/arts/music/hamlet-opera-met.html) But this review is going to be from my perspective, not his, as this month, Da'ud Bob reviews the PBS Great Performances airing of the Metropolitan Opera's presentation of Brett Dean's Hamlet.

Starring Allan Clayton in the title role, with Brenda Rae as Ophelia, Rod Gilfrey as Claudius, Sarah Connelly as Gertrude, William Burden as Polonius, John Relyea as the Ghost (as well as playing the King of the players and the Gravedigger), David Butt Philip as Laertes, Aryeh Nussbaum Cohen and Christopher Lowrey as Rosencrantz and Guildenstern, and Jacques Imbrailo, the basic story here is the same as in every other production of Hamlet, the biggest difference is that everyone is singing nearly everything, and some of the scenes, lines, and characters have been rearranged to show up in different places.

HAMLET, Pt 3, Cont'd Da'ud Bob Review,

For example, Rosenkrantz and Guildenstern show up both earlier and later in the action here than they do in the Shakespearean play.

Bad points: Well, we don't have Shakespeare's words, so there's that. And, frankly, I rather missed both the Fool and "poor Tom. (And yet, neither one was truly necessary in this film version of the play).


