




We are thrilled at becoming your next Baron and Baroness at Changeover event next month! We're looking forward to in-person





A Tablet Weaving Loom on a Budget

Tablet weaving is appropriate for a very wide variety of personas, and trim or a belt can really elevate a set of garb. However, the equipment requirements are fairly intimidating to the novice weaver; a standard inkle loom generally costs at least a hundred dollars plus shipping.

This tutorial aims to get you fully set up to weave for less than that!

These plans are for a warp weighted loom, which has a few advantages over an inkle.

The biggest one is that you don't need to worry about building up twist while weaving an unbalanced pattern.

The second advantage is that you're not constrained by the max warp length of an inkle loom (I will admit that this is sometimes a disadvantage, I have gotten very bored by the unwise decision to warp up 10 yards of the same thing).

The other disadvantage is that a WWL is not very portable; an attempt to take work to an event or an A&S gathering is likely to require you to spend a bit of time putting your warp back in order before you can begin whereas an inkle room is much more ready to go. So with that laid out, let's go hit the box stores!

Shopping List

From a hardware store:

 $6' \frac{1}{2}$ " diameter schedule 40 PVC (this is the white pipe, the thinnest you can find. They come in

2' or 10' increments, three of the two footers is all you need) 2 1/2-in x 1/2-in x 1/2-in dia 90-Degree Tee PVC Fitting (two T junctions that fit your pipe)

2 1/2-in x 1/2-in dia 90-Degree Slip Elbow PVC Fitting (two elbow junctions that fit your pipe)

2 6" quick release bar clamps (you might have these in your garage already, though)

From an office supply store:

1/4" capacity binder clips, you'll need as many as you plan on having cards

Possibly also a single very large clip, but maybe this one is from the office supply cabinet

From a sporting goods store:

3 oz lead fishing weights, ideally in a not-pointy shape. You'll need as many as you plan on having cards. As of spring '22, these cost a little over a dollar each, but there are patterns that can be done on nine cards so you don't need TOO many.

From a craft store or maybe your stash:

Maybe Crochet Thread in size 10 in two or more colors you like, maybe yarn from your stash!

Maybe Amazon, maybe homemade:

Tablets - 2" square tablets either purchased or made from cardboard or thin plastic sheet.

Miscellaneous stuff that's probably in your house: Saw, glue, nail polish or paint, two 6" quick release bar clamps.

Gisla Œðikollr, Part 3

Construction

Saw one of the two foot lengths into half, and then saw off three inches of each of the other lengths.

Now that you have two 12" lengths, two 21" lengths

and two 3" lengths, assemble them as shown (this photo also explains the use of bar clamps). Some glue will be required in every joint; I used hot glue so

that I could use it immediately but pretty much anything will work.

If you would prefer your loom to look more unobtrusive at an event, nail polish remover will get rid of the printed on text, and then an artistic smear of

brown shoe polish does a surprisingly good job at replicating wood grain.

Okay, that's the loom part of "warp weighted loom", so now on to the weights!

If you trust yourself to not chew on your fingers while working on weaving, you can skip the paint step and also I envy you. I took the time to coat most of the surface of my weights with nail polish and then once dried, removed one set of the wires from a binder clip, threaded it through the weight and then reattached it.

Warping

By setting your bar clamps a fair distance away and bar-portion-up, you can use them as an impromptu warping board. I condense the excess warp by turning each tablet's worth of cards into a single crochet chain, and then attach the weighted binder clip to the loop at the top.

Weaving!

There are a torrent of Youtube videos, Facebook groups and other tutorials for getting started with weaving and now that you have a loom you're ready to start exploring them!



HAMLET, PRINCE OF DENMARK

Bob ibn Briggs Historical Drive-In Movie Critic "We watch 'em so you don't have to."

So, continuing our series of movie reviews of the latest additions to my "Shakespeare Shelf" at home, we come to this one - yet another version of one of William Shakespeare's most popular plays. To add insult to injury, in looking on-line for the full cast list, I found at least three other versions that I do not already own (and which have now been added to my Amazon wish list) and one that I would like to own but cannot find to purchase. (This last, being a film from Denmark, is probably not available in the NTSC format, so I wouldn't be able to watch it even if I had it, without buying an "all-regions" DVD or Blu-Ray player. Or flying it to Europe and to watch it there which, although tempting, probably does not have the best cost-to-benefit ratio. Just savin'.) Anyway, this month's movie was obtained as one in a boxed set of the plays of William Shakespeare done in the late 1970s and early 1980s by the BBC ("the Beeb") and Time-Life Books, originally made for television, so you just know right off the bat that it's going to be a mix of high standards for actors, costuming, and fidelity to the original text, coupled with pretty obvious attempts to keep production costs down. Let's see how well they did with that balancing act as this month, Da'ud Bob reviews for you the 1980 production of Hamlet, Prince of Denmark.

Starring Derek Jacobi (just four years after his tour-de-force in I, Claudius) in the title role, with Patrick Stewart as Claudius (a role he would reprise in 2009 to David Tennant's Hamlet; funnily enough, Derek Jacobi would play Claudius in Kenneth Branagh's 1996 Hamlet), Claire Bloom as Gertrude, Eric Porter as Polonius, Lalla Ward as Ophelia, David Robb as Laertes, Patrick Allen as the Ghost of Hamlet's Father, Robert Swann as Horatio, Jonathan Hyde as Rosenkrantz, Geoffrey Bateman as Guildenstern, and Emrys James as the First Player, you should know the plot of this one from all of the other productions of this play that I have reviewed thus far.



In brief, Hamlet comes home from university to find his uncle married to his mother, and his father's ghost haunting the battlements and scaring the watch. Then his father's ghost directs him to seek revenge on his uncle for "murder most foul."

Good points: Once again, it's Shakespeare's words. (Interesting fact: Shakespeare's works contain first-ever recordings of 2,035 English words, including critical, frugal, excellent, barefaced, assassination, and countless. [Source: FactRetriever.com]) Much of the armor. Much of the costuming, which mostly come from the time of Shakespeare. The fire-basket. Polonius is as verbose as ever. Queen Gertrude's four-poster bed and its trappings. The banners. The table tomb. The sword fighting choreography is better than usual.

Bad points: The Ghost's ridiculously long cape. I have my doubts about Hamlet's hose and codpiece. Some of the heraldic banners have questionable "heraldry" on them. Young Fortinbras' armor.

Zero breasts. ½ gallon of blood. Five dead bodies. Sword fu. Dagger fu. Poison fu. Fisticuffs. Expectoration fu. Hamlet rolls. Skulls roll. Hamlet and Laertes roll. King Claudius rolls. Gratuitous fog. Gratuitous fire breather. Gratuitous drum. Gratuitous application of rouge. Academy Award nomination to Derek Jacobi for his interesting take on Hamlet's soliloquy, and for showing throughout the play his wide range as an actor: manic; melancholy; angry (although his anger seems to me a little overdone at times); hurt; loud; soft. A mere 27 on the Vomit Meter. 3½ Stars. Da'ud Bob says, "It's really weird to see Patrick Stewart – who teased co-star Lalla Ward because at the time of this movie, she was appearing in Doctor Who. Stewart told her he wouldn't be caught dead doing science fiction – in a beard with a nearly full head of hair. All in all, it's a well above average production of Hamlet. Check it out!"

Winter's Gate Arts and Sciences


